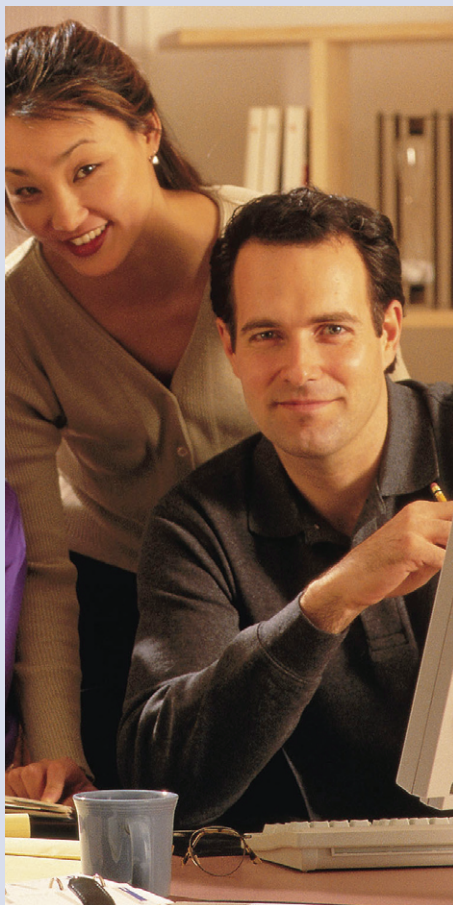

How-to: MissionInsite Registration

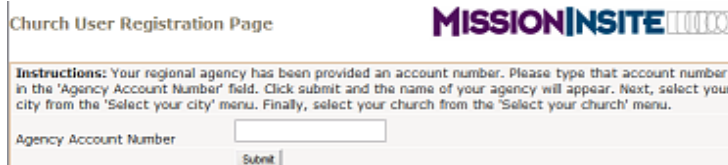
Open an internet browser such as Internet Explorer or Firefox and go to the MissionInsite website at www.missioninsite.com



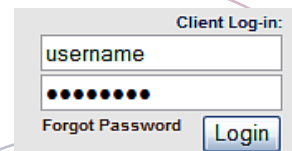
Begin your orientation by clicking on Resources under Mission Resources for Local Churches. On the Resource page view the Local Church Getting Started Tutorial. After you view the Tutorial, download the Introductory Local Church User Guide and the MI Demographic Segments Guide (*Quick Look*). Greater segment detail is contained in the MI Demographic Segments Guide (*Detail Look*) and in the Interactive Multimedia Guide to MOSAIC. The User Guide will provide additional assistance in navigating the study areas and the MI Demographic Segments Guide provides the descriptions of the MOSAIC Segments. These will prepare you for accessing the extensive information available to you.



Click on the "Local Church" tab at top of screen. On the drop down menu, click on "Church Registration". Review each step prior to beginning the Registration process. Click on the link in Step 2 to begin the Registration Process. A new dialogue box will appear asking you for your Agency Account



Number. After entering your Agency Account Number complete the registration process. Following the E-mail validation step you will be ready to login to your study area with your newly created Username and Password.
