

## URGENT NEED

Dr. Michael Tut, a former “lost boy” of Sudan, is in dire need of our support to continue his work at the Akobo Hospital in south Sudan. After graduating medical school, Dr. Tut returned to his country to rescue an almost-abandoned hospital (four beds and a technician) in Southern Sudan. Today Akobo Hospital has 68 beds and two doctors and is the only medical facility of its kind within 100 miles for a population of more than 232,000 people. According to a recent report, the need for the medical care is so great people are traveling long distances, walking up to 6 days, from neighboring counties to receive medical care at the hospital. Dr. Michael is making a difference in the area for example the infant mortality rate dropped from 8% to .5% since he has been at the hospital.

The problem is the Sudanese gov’t has stopped paying Dr. Tut, and he has a family to support. Without our support, Dr. Tut will not be able to continue his work in Akobo. There is a critical need for his services at the hospital and our support is essential.
